Pattern 1. Knit a Poppy (or a flower) 'flat shape with petals' quite a difficult pattern.



1 ball red double knitting yarn, (or chosen colour)

Scrap of black yarn for centre (or chosen colour)

Pair of size 8 or 4 mm pins

Body of poppy using red, cast on 84 sts

Row 1: (RS) K20, W&T (Bring yarn to front, slip next st purlwise, bring yarn back, slip slipped st back on to left hand needle and turn)

Row 2: (WS) K2 tog tbl, K14, K2 tog, W&T

Row 3: (RS) K2 tog tbl, K11, K2 tog, W&T

Row 4: (WS) K2 tog tbl, K8, K2 tog, W&T

Row 5: (RS) K2 tog tbl, K5, K2 tog, W&T

Row 6: (WS) K2 tog tbl, K2, K2 tog, W&T

Row 7: (RS) K3, K2 tog, W&T

Row 8: (WS) K4, K2 tog, W&T

Row 9: (RS) K5, K2 tog, W&T

Row 10: (WS) K5, K2 tog, W&T

Row 11: (RS) K2 tog tbl, K1, K2 tog, K1

This leaves you RS facing with 5 sts on the right hand needle and the next 21 ready to go on the left needle.

Repeat Rows 1 – 11 three more times. When you've done all 4 petals, you'll have 20 sts left.

Next Row: Join black, K to end

Next Row: K2 tog to end (10 sts)

Break off yarn leaving a long tail and thread back through remaining stitches and pull tight.

Join edges.

Pattern 2. Knit a Poppy (or a flower) 'flat shape with frilled edge' easy pattern.



1 ball red double knitting yarn, (or chosen colour)

Scrap of black yarn for centre (or chosen colour)

Pair of size 8 or 4 mm pins

Body of Poppy using red, cast on 102 stitches

Rows 1 – 4 Knit

Row 5: S1, K2 tog, psso to end

Rows 6 – 9 Knit

Row 10: K2 tog to end

Rows 11 & 12 Knit

Row 13: Join in black and Knit to end

Row 14: Knit

Row 15: K2 sts tog to end

Break off yarn leaving a long tail and thread back through remaining stitches and pull tight.

Join edges.

Pattern 3. Knit a Poppy (or a flower) 'cupped shape' easy pattern



1 ball red double knitting yarn, (or chosen colour) Scrap of black yarn for centre (or chosen colour) Pair of size 8 or 4 mm pins

Body of Poppy using red, cast on 60 stitches

Rows 1-8: K2, P2 across the row

Row 9: Join in black and K across the row

Row 10: P2 tog across the row (30 stitches).

Row 11: Slip 1, K2 tog, psso to end.

Break off yarn leaving a long tail and thread back through remaining stitches and pull tight.

Join edges.
